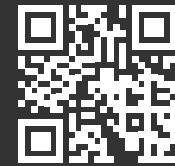

OVERVIEW

This medically developed professional skin peeling treatment is based on a **complex of micronised, biologically active herbs** - including Chamomilla recutita, Salvia officinalis, Polygonum aviculare, Plantago lanceolata, and Spirulina maxima, among others. The complex consists of a total of 14 herbs. They were selected based on information about traditional, folk and herbal medicine. The herbs have since undergone scientific analyses, in particular by the government appointed German Commission E and other scientists.

The dried herbs are firmly massaged into the skin. Their unique shape and texture result in a mild abrasive action, which contributes to visible peeling over the following 48–72 hours. This **mechanical stimulation**, combined with the natural composition of the herbs (rich in **chlorophyll, flavonoids, trace minerals, enzymes, and natural acids**), is believed to support the skin's natural exfoliation and renewal processes.

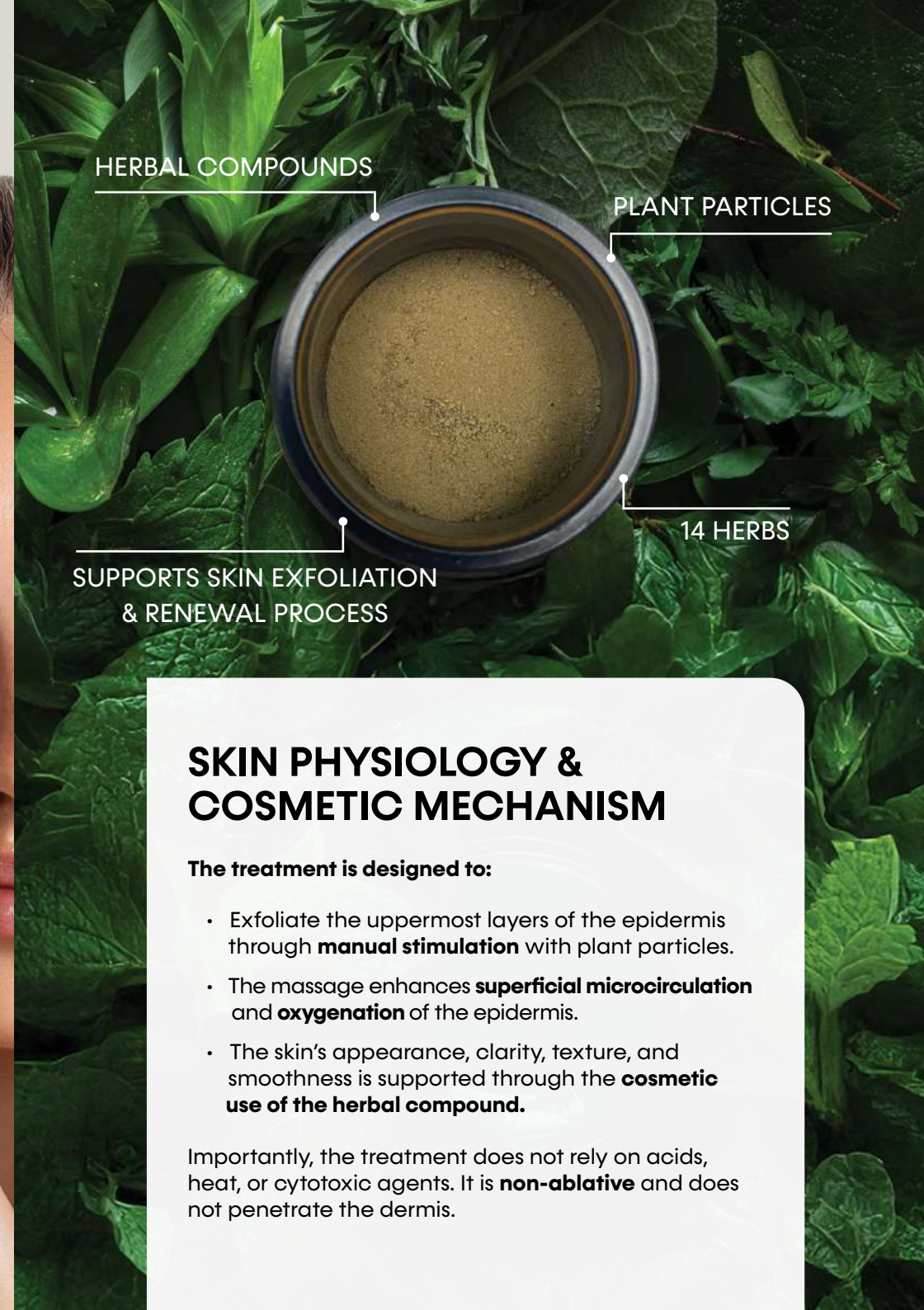
A typical example of the skin on day 4 after treatment:

SKIN PHYSIOLOGY & COSMETIC MECHANISM

The treatment is designed to:

- Exfoliate the uppermost layers of the epidermis through **manual stimulation** with plant particles.
- The massage enhances **superficial microcirculation** and **oxygenation** of the epidermis.
- The skin's appearance, clarity, texture, and smoothness is supported through the **cosmetic use of the herbal compound**.

Importantly, the treatment does not rely on acids, heat, or cytotoxic agents. It is **non-ablative** and does not penetrate the dermis.

SCIENTIFIC SUPPORT

While the herbal complex itself is not registered as a medicine, the compound, supporting products and protocol were established in trials at a German dermatological hospital. The individual herbs have been studied for their **dermatological, antimicrobial, anti-inflammatory, and antioxidant properties**. Examples include:

- **Chamomilla recutita:** Known for its calming effects on the skin (supported by Phytomedicine and J Ethnopharmacology publications).
- **Spirulina maxima:** Rich in phycocyanin and minerals, with antioxidant activity (J Medicinal Food, Oxidative Medicine and Cellular Longevity).
- **Plantago lanceolata:** Traditionally used for wound support and anti-inflammatory purposes (Fitoterapia journal, various ethnobotanical reviews).
- **Salvia officinalis:** Documented antimicrobial and antioxidant actions.

This herbal peeling procedure has a history of over 60 years, improving the appearance of a variety of skin concerns with high levels of safety. A series of before-and-after photographs is available for review, illustrating the visible outcomes achieved across a range of skin presentations using the herbal resurfacing method.
